Aluminum & Steel Cans

Aluminum foil, pie pans, empty aerosol cans. Cans need to be rinsed with water. (Only at all convenience centers in the onsite scrap metal container.)

- Tires—up to 5 passenger tires allowed per month
- Lead Acid Batteries

- Dried out paint only. No wet paint accepted.
